Welcome to the Blindeninstitut Rückersdorf!

We are a private support centre with a focus on "Seeing and further support needs". Besides visual impairment or blindness, the children, youths and young adults who spend their school time with us have further support needs in the areas of cognitive, motoric and/or social-emotional development. Our range of care begins with early support for babies and small children up until school enrolment.

In our school preparation facility (SVE), pre-school children from the age of 3 years can be supported in the SVE groups. Attendance at the school is possible over 13 school years until the end of the school attendance period. At the end of the school attendance period, the young adults leave us and move on to a workshop or support centre for adults.

Included in our school is a remedial day-care centre in which the children can be cared for in the afternoon until 16:00 hours. Normally, the pupils are picked up at home by bus in the morning and brought back home again in the afternoon.





There is also the possibility for children and youths to live on our premises throughout the year, in residential units at Dachsberg. Specialist staff from various educational and medical occupations work with the children in classes and groups with five to seven children.

Our own Therapy Department enables physiotherapy, ergo therapy, speech therapy, psychotherapy and social therapeutic measures. The individual requirements and possibilities for supporting your child are holistically considered.

The costs for the school, supervision and treatment are borne by the government, the district and the health insurance fund. For this purpose, an application must be submitted and approval provided. Parents need pay only a small contribution for the care, e.g. for lunch.

Dear Parents,

Here is some important detailed information for you regarding our facility:

- 1. What does my child need every day? To be brought with them daily!
 - Aids e.g. glasses, white cane
 - Emergency folder (emergency questionnaire, Diazepam)
 - Home/school diary (means of information transfer)
 - Food and drink for mornings and afternoons (your child will receive lunch from us)
 - Special nutrition (in case of percutaneous endoscopic gastrostomy (PEG) for the whole day
 - Medication which must be administered to your child whilst they are with us
 - A current medical prescription for all medication which we administer whilst the child is in the facility (e.g. seizure medication, emergency medication, antipyretics)
- 2. What may my child require? If required, please send with them!
 - Spare change of clothing
 - Slippers or warm socks
 - Sufficient nappies, wet-wipes, cream
 - Toothbrush, toothpaste and tooth mug
 - Swimwear and towel, incontinence protection
 - Orthoses, corset, similar support aids



3. What happens if my child is ill?

Your child must remain at home

- In case of infectious illnesses, e.g. scarlet fever, German measles, chickenpox
- In case of fever over 38.5°C
- In case of infections with vomiting and diarrhoea
- In case of flu-like infections with heavy coughs and sniffling Please consider that other children may also become infected!
- Please inform the bus driver that your child need not be picked up.
- Please call the school secretary under telephone number 0911/9577-113 and excuse your child from lessons!
- Only once your child has spent an entire day healthy and without fever may they return to school again.





Following a seizure with the administration of diazepam or a sleepless night, please check whether your child can actively participate at school and the day-care centre.

There is no doctor on-site in our facility who can treat your child. In case of emergency, we will call a paramedic who will normally hospitalise your child.

- 4. What information do I write into the home/school diary?
 - Physical constitution / irregularities
 - Seizure occurrence
 - Problematic sleeping situations (your child had little or insufficient sleep)
 - Bowel movement problems
 - New medication and medication change
 - Please enclose a new medical prescription!
 - Particular situations at home which have had an effect on the behaviour and wellbeing of your child
 - How much breakfast did my child have at home?
 - Your current telephone number and availability in case of an emergency and if your child becomes ill! (Sick children will be sent home. Parents must organise transportation back home)

In general, we require a copy of all medical reports for our medical therapies.



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
